GENERAL PRINCIPLE

This method is intended for use on pile floor coverings to determine the resistance to staining by acid food colors. Twenty milliliters (ml) of staining solution (Red Dye 40) is applied to an area of the specimen. After 24 hours the stain is cleaned and a visual rating is assessed by use of the AATCC Red 40 Stain Scale, where a grade of 10 is no staining and 1 is severely stained.
